



Construction and Demolition Waste Acceptance Form

To protect the health and safety of our employees and customers, all loads of construction, remodeling and demolition waste brought to Metro Central or Metro South transfer stations are thoroughly screened for materials that may contain asbestos. This precaution is coupled with paperwork required for all such loads of waste hauled in a drop-box or by building trade contractors (account or cash customers). In addition, analytical test results are required for the following products commonly known to contain asbestos:

- Plaster and decorative plaster
- Flooring: vinyl tiles, vinyl sheet, cove base molding and mastic
- Acoustical ceiling tiles, ceiling texture (“popcorn”) and spray-on texture
- Cement siding (Transite)
- Various forms of insulation: blown-in, spray-applied, vermiculite, pipe, HVAC and lagging
- Electrical wire insulation and panel partitions
- Other: fire doors, fire brick, fireproofing

INSTRUCTIONS

- This form should be completed by the person responsible for and knowledgeable about the contents of the load.
- For multiple-load projects, copies of this form will be accepted, but the contents of the load must match the description of the waste materials on the form.
- All parties involved (generator, contractor and hauler) may be held responsible for abatement of unacceptable materials unloaded at Metro's transfer station, including costs for testing, abatement, fines and administration.
