METRO CODE - TITLE V SOLID WASTE

CHAPTER 5.00 SOLID WASTE DEFINITIONS

The proposed changes under Ordinance 15-1363 would add new terms and amend current definitions in Chapter 5.00 as follows:

"Automotive shedder residual" means the processing residual that remains after recyclable metals have been removed from shredded automobiles and household appliances. Such waste primarily consists of non-metallic materials.

"Beneficial use" means the productive use of solid waste in a manner that will not create an adverse impact to public health, safety, welfare or environment as approved under a beneficial use determination by the state environmental protection agency.

"Cleanup material" means solid waste resulting from the excavation or cleanup of releases of hazardous substances into the environment, including street sweeping waste, non-hazardous contaminated soils that do not qualify as clean fill, such as petroleum contaminated soils, and sandbags contaminated debris resulting from the cleanup of chemical spills or releases. Cleanup material contaminated by hazardous substances does not include solid waste generated by manufacturing or industrial processes.

"Dismantler" means an automobile dismantling business as provided in ORS 822.100.

"Useful material" means material that still has or retains useful physical, chemical, or biological properties after serving its original purpose(s) or function(s), and which, when separated from solid waste, is suitable for reuse in the same manner or other purpose(s) beneficial use when separated from solid waste. Types of useful materials are: material that can be reused; recyclable material; organic material(s) suitable for controlled biological decomposition such as for making compost; material used in the preparation of fuel; material intended to be clean fill used, and which is in fact used, for construction or land reclamation such as inert material for fill, and material intended to be used, and which is in fact used, productively in; and other materials that the operation state environmental protection agency has approved for beneficial use outside of
