# Volunteer opportunity

## Group Restoration

### Division / Program

Land Management / Natural Areas Land Management

### Purpose

To restore natural habitat, making it a better place for wildlife, plants, and people.

### Responsibilities

- Work with the volunteer coordinator to identify your groups needs.
- Projects may include removing invasive plants, planting native ones, creating wildlife piles, working on trails, collecting seed, or one of many other tasks depending on the season and your group's capacity.
- Show up for your project ready to work!

### Required knowledge, skills, and abilities

- Transportation to and from assigned site.
- Capable of performing physical labor that includes walking, bending, and lifting up to 20 lbs.
- Comfortable working outdoors and willingness to work in adverse conditions including rain, cold, dust, heat, and heavy pollen.

### Time Commitment

Group restoration projects generally last 2-3 hours. Groups can volunteer once or multiple times.
