

EXPLORE the PORTLAND METRO AREA

nature areas, hiking paths and
bike paths in the Portland Metro
area this summer.



Forest Park is the largest wooded urban area in the United States. It stretches for more than 8 miles!

The 51 mile **Big Eastside Trail Loop** takes you through city streets and natural areas

More than **200 bird species** pass through the Portland Metro area each year.

There are almost **70,000 acres** of parks and wooded areas in the Portland Metro Area.

On a clear day you can see **Mt. Hood, Mt. Saint Helens, and Mt. Adams** from downtown Portland.

HILLSBORO
The **Banks-Vernonia State Trail** offers 21 miles of uninterrupted car-free riding.

Mt. Tabor, Rocky Butte, Powell Butte and Kelly Butte are all extinct volcanoes in the Portland Metro Area that can be reached by bike or bus!

FOREST GROVE

BEAVERTON
Take the Trimet bus to **Fanno Creek Greenway Trail** and explore the 15 mile tributary.

Portland's **4T trail** is a loop that goes from MAX to trail to tram to street car.

Bike along the **Springwater Corridor**, through parks, trails and neighborhoods along Johnson Creek from downtown Portland to Boring, Oregon.

Public transportation can take you anywhere in the Metro area!
79 bus lines, 4 Max lines, 2 street car lines and the **Wes**.
