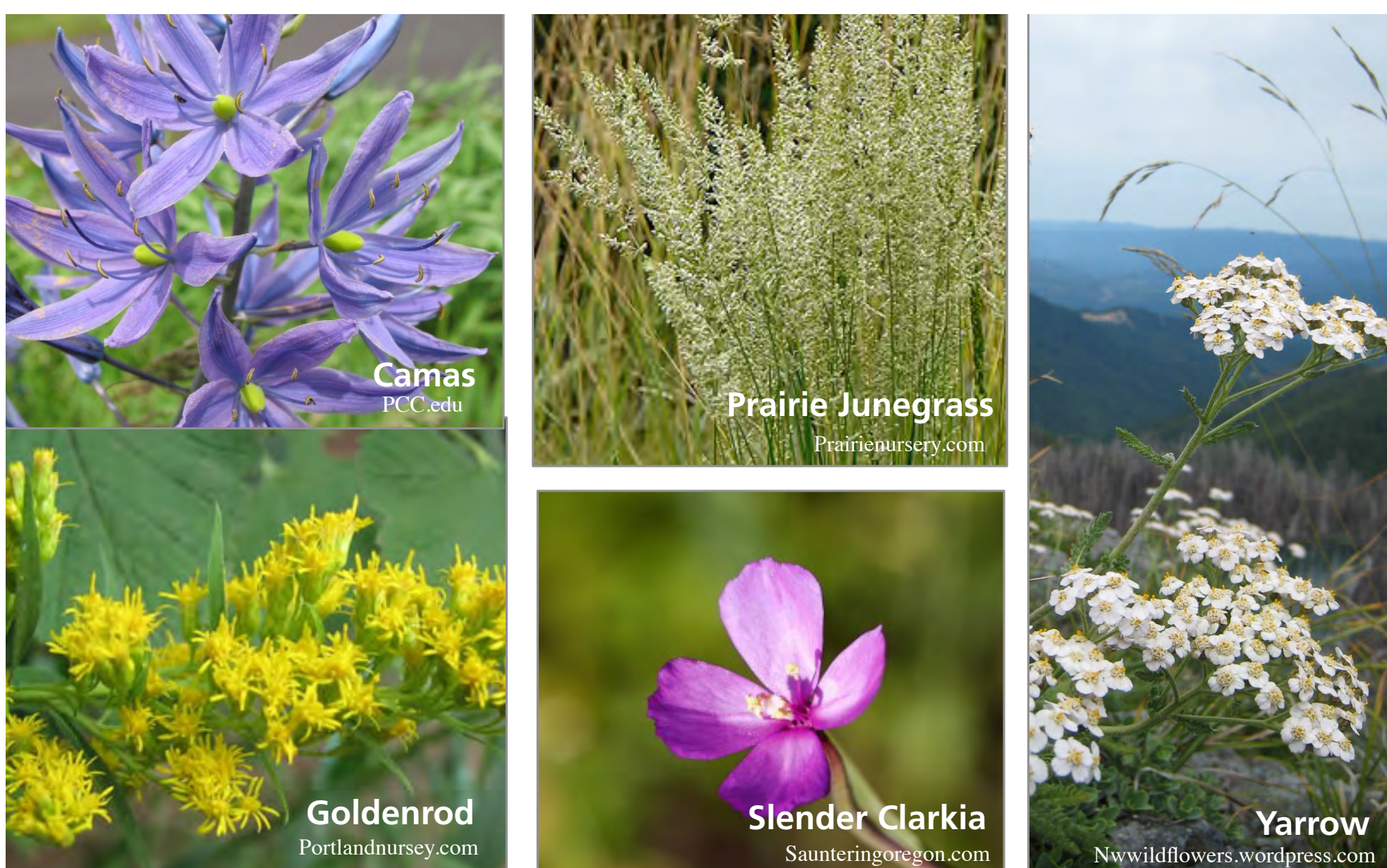


A trail for people and for wildlife

Restoring prairie habitat is part of the Westside Trail master plan

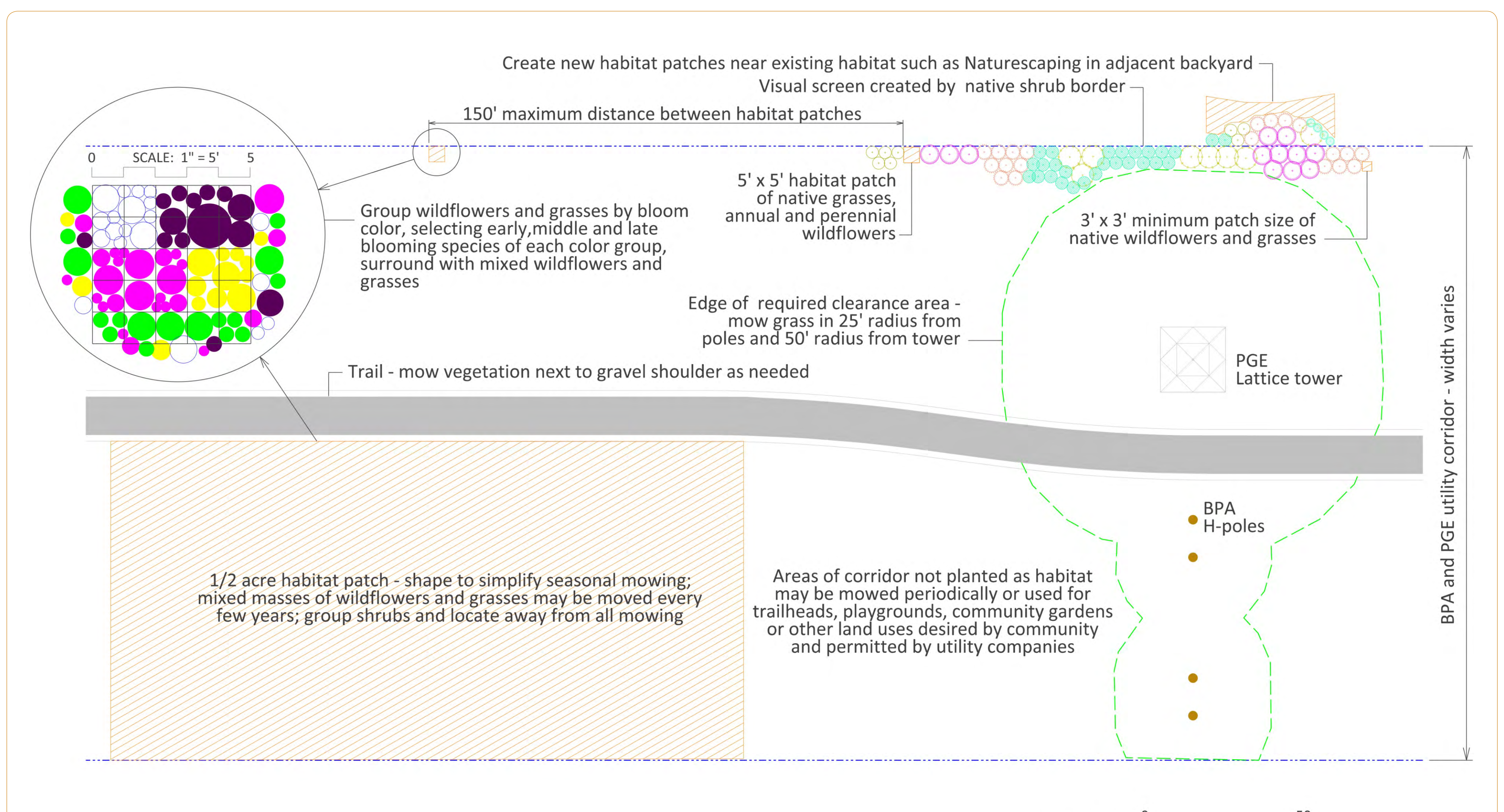


Wildlife:
