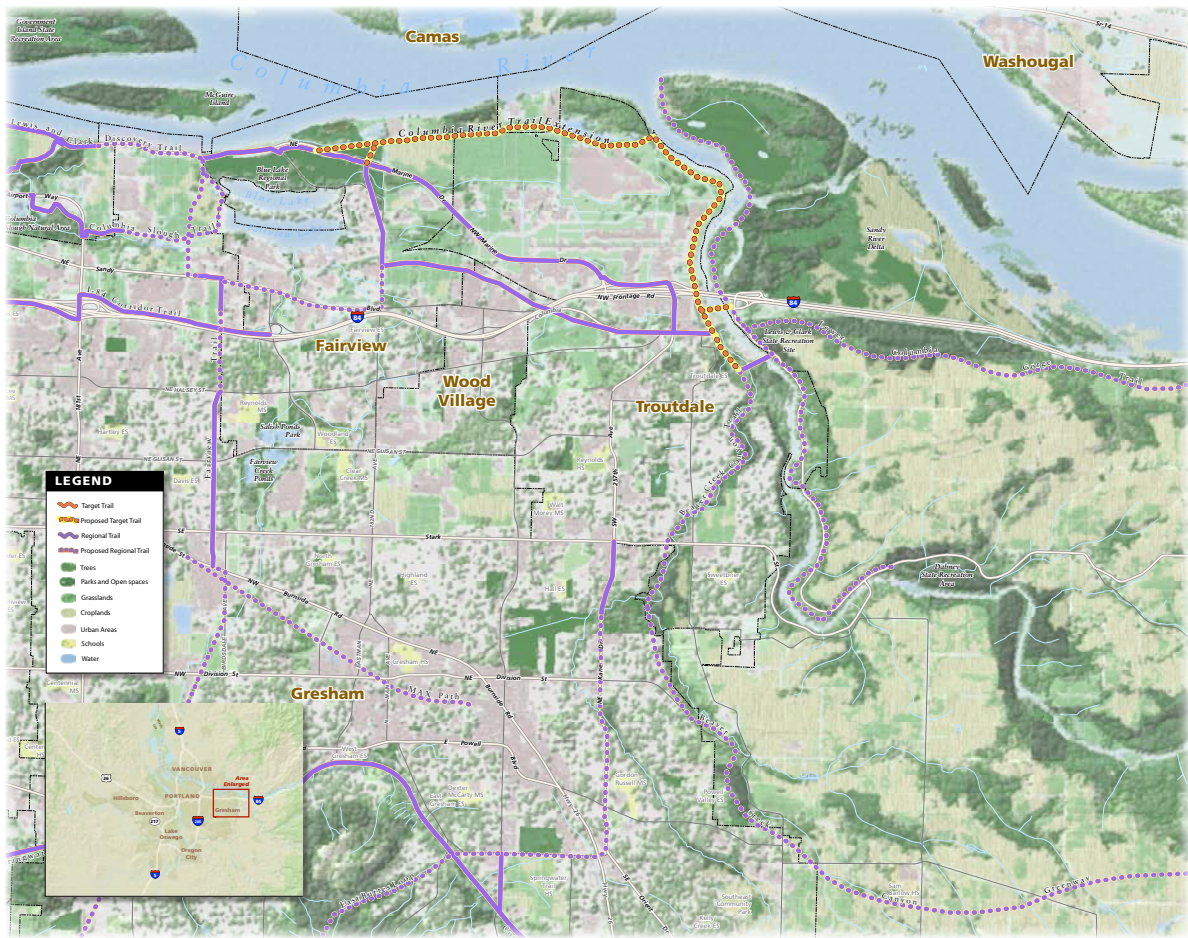


Sandy River Connections
