Subject: Regional Transportation Functional Plan – process to request extension to deadline

PURPOSE

This memo provides guidance on how Metro will administer requests for extensions from the compliance deadlines for Regional Transportation Functional Plan (RTFP).

BACKGROUND

The Regional Transportation Functional Plan (RTFP) is part of Metro Code (Chapter 3.08) and implements the policies contained in the Regional Transportation Plan. Per the Oregon Transportation Planning Rule (TPR), Cities and Counties local transportation system plans and implementing ordinances must be consistent with the RTFP.

The original deadlines for RTFP compliance were developed in consultation with individual jurisdictions prior to adoption of the RTFP in 2010. The updated deadlines (see attachment 1) reflect extensions requested in Fall 2012.

EXTENSION REQUESTS

The RTFP allows a city or county to seek an extension of time for compliance using a form provided by Metro. (See attachment 2). Electronic copies in Word format are available to download at www.oregonmetro.gov/tsp For efficiency of processing, please submit the extension form to Metro's COO between November 1 and November 15. The criteria for receiving an extension is as follows:

- 1) Progress has been made toward compliance, or
- 2) There is good cause for failing to meet the deadline for compliance.

Upon receipt of an extension request, Metro will notify ODOT as required by the RTFP and will post the request on its website. Metro's COO is required to issue an order approving or denying the request within 30 days.
