Requests for extensions of Regional Transportation Functional Plan (RTFP) compliance deadlines, as authorized in Title 6 of the plan, must be filed with Metro's Chief Operating Officer (COO) on this application form.

Metro Code, 3.08.620, sets forth the criteria and procedure for Metro consideration of extensions of compliance deadlines. The criteria, from Metro Code 3.08.620(B), are as follows:

The Chief Operating Officer may grant an extension if:

- (1) the city or county is making progress toward compliance or
- (2) there is good cause for failure to meet the deadline for compliance.

Multnomah County would like to amend our RTP Compliance Deadline for local TSPs to 12/31/16. This includes the amendment for the Urban Pockets TSP. The planning for this will be in partnership with the City of Portland. This request brings us in line with the City's submitted extension of 12/31/16.

The County's urban roads are also addressed in TSP updates for cities of Fairview, Troutdale and Wood Village, and City of Gresham for the Pleasant Valley and Springwater Corridor Plan Areas. The County coordinates with the cities on their TSPs as part of compliance with the RTP. The cities of Gresham and Troutdale have recently completed their TSP updates and are in compliance with the RTFP. The County will continue working with the cities of Wood Village and Fairview, both who are recipients of TGM grants, to complete their TSP work. The County will also amend its Comprehensive Framework Plan Transportation Elements as part of RTP compliance as part of the two year County Comprehensive Plan Update process that the County just kicked off in November. To align with the Fairview and Wood Village updates, the County would like to amend our deadline to 12/31/16.
