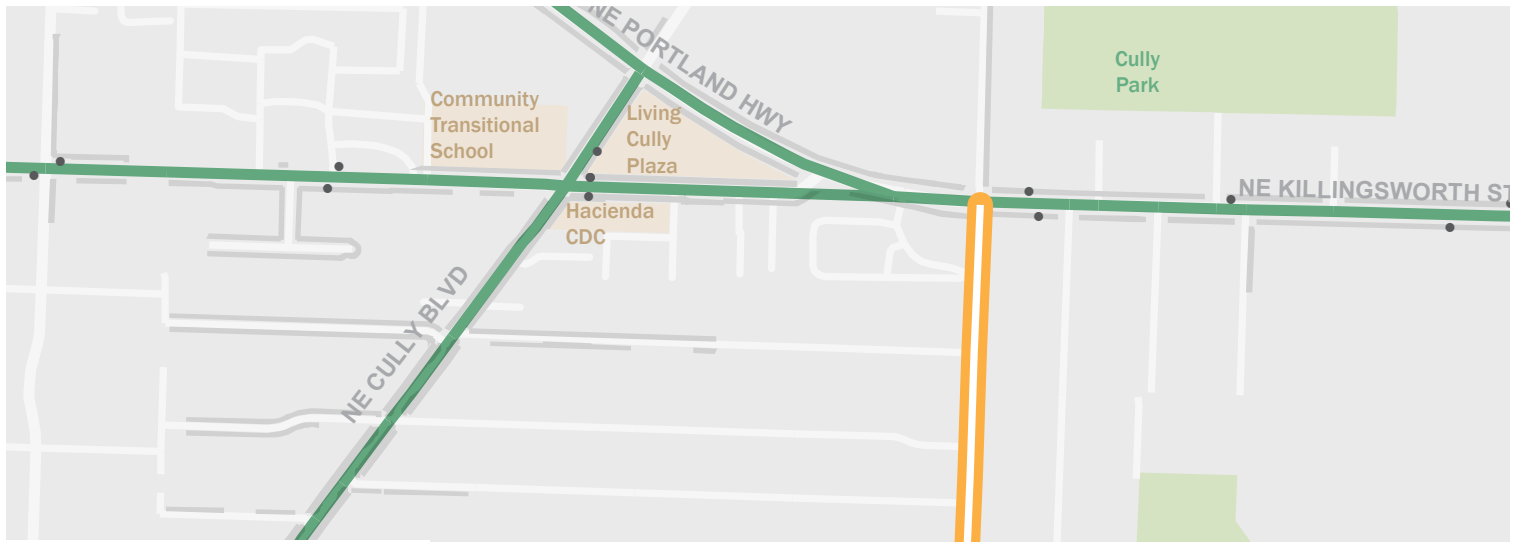
### Project Description

<b>Project name:</b>	Cully Walking and Biking Parkway
<b>Applicant jurisdiction:</b>	City of Portland
<b>Facility or area:</b>	NE 72nd Ave from NE Sandy Blvd to NE Killingsworth St, in City of Portland.
<b>Beginning facility or milepost:</b>	NE 72nd Ave & NE Sandy Blvd
<b>Ending facility or milepost:</b>	NE 72nd Ave & NE Killingsworth St
<b>Provide a brief description of the project elements:</b>	Provide a high-quality pedestrian and bicycle parkway along NE 72nd Ave through the heart of Cully. This project will connect Cully residents to nearby commercial areas and schools, provide multimodal accessibility to parks and green space in Cully and Roseway, and will connect to the future 70s Bikeway to the south. The project would construct a neighborhood greenway with traffic calming and crossing improvements from Sandy to Prescott, physically separated pedestrian and bicycle pathways on the west side of 72 <sup>nd</sup> from Prescott to Sumner, and a shared multi-use path on the west side of 72 <sup>nd</sup> from Sumner to Killingsworth. The project will also include lighting, street trees, and place-making elements.
