## **EQUITABLE HOUSING PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT GRANTS GRANT AWARDS MADE IN 2016**

The Metro Council awarded \$575,000 to seven projects to reduce barriers to equitable housing in communities across greater Portland. This was a special cycle made possible by higher-than-anticipated revenues from the construction excise tax.
