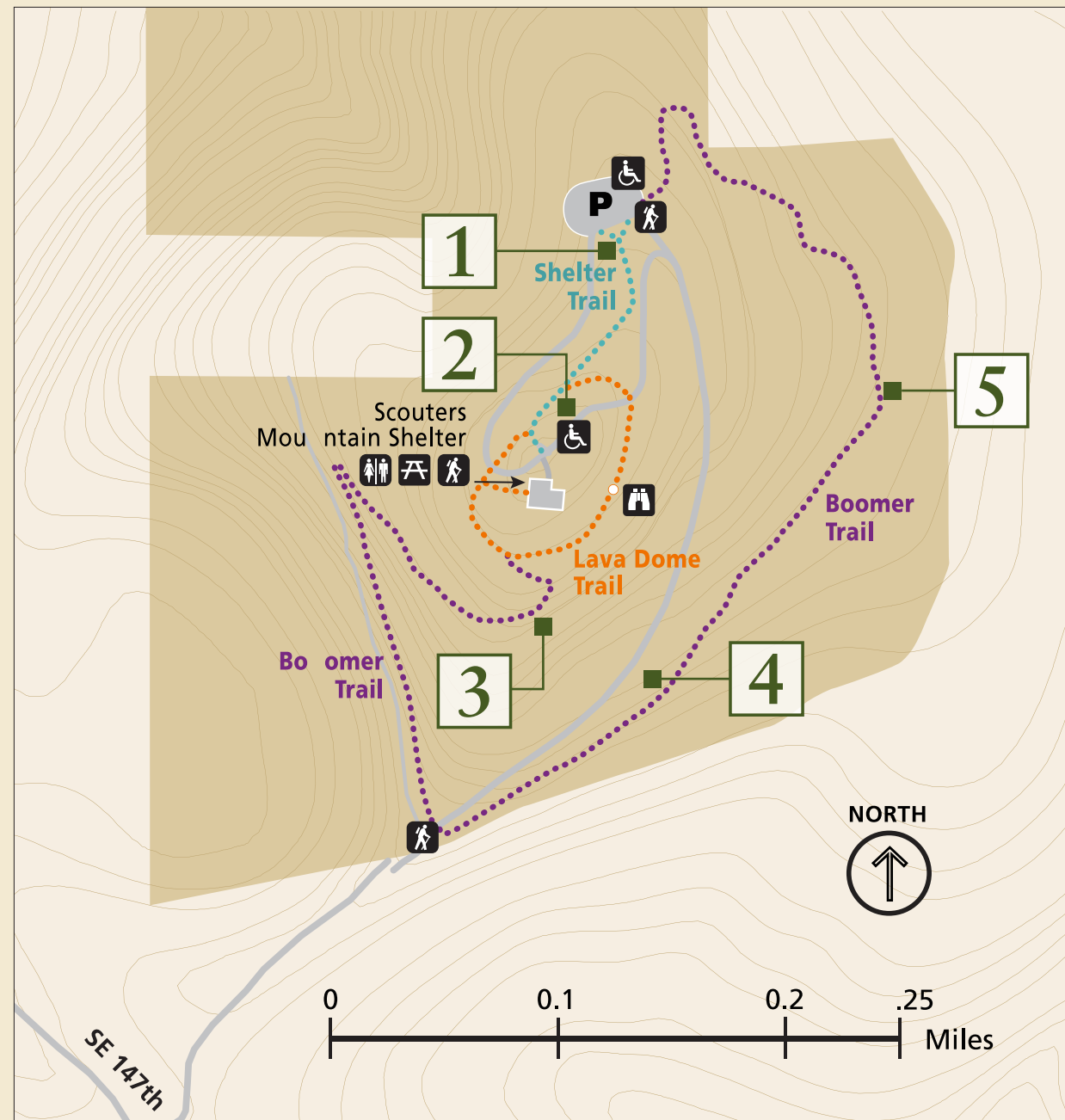


Habitat *by John Christensen*

The forest environment of Scouters Mountain inspired artist John Christensen to create “Habitat,” a five-piece collection on display along the trails. During a visit, Christensen noticed the colonies of small ferns, fungi, mosses and lichens. His artwork re-creates these small communities on a larger scale. Their placement on the benches – made of timber salvaged from the site – invites visitors to think about the shared environments that support people and nature.

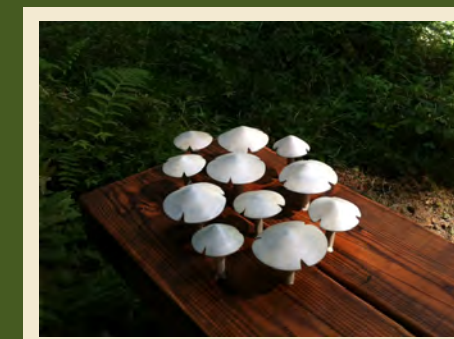
