Dear Ms. Kranz:

The short-term license extension request that Tidewater Barge Lines submitted to Metro has been approved. Attached is a copy of Metro Solid Waste Facility License No. L-183-17B for your records. I recommend that you review the terms of the license carefully.

Please note, section 5.15 of L-183-17 requires written authorization from Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) prior to operations re-commencing at Sundial. Metro reserves the right to re-evaluate this license based on requirement established by DEQ.

The term of this license is one additional year, expiring August 1, 2019. If Tidewater Barge Lines seeks to extend this license beyond August 1, 2019, it must apply for a solid waste license renewal.

Under Metro Code Chapter 2.05, you have the right to request a contested case hearing regarding the provisions contained in the license. In order to do so, you must make this request in writing and ensure that Metro receives the request within 30 days of the date this letter was mailed. Any such request should be directed to my attention at Metro. You may retain legal counsel to represent you at the hearing. Article IX, Section 14 of the Oregon Constitution, the Metro Charter, ORS Chapter 268, and Metro Code Chapters 2.05 and 5.01 provide Metro's authority and jurisdiction for the hearing.
