The purpose of this bundled amendment to make necessary funding corrections, increases, fund reprogramming, and add new projects to the 2018-21 MTIP as noted in the included project tables as part of Formal MTIP AmendmentAG19-01-AUG. The MTIP represents the first four-year implementation program to Metro's long range Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). Project changes primarily are addressing corrections and updates for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY 2019 and later.

Subject to revisions to address comments received during the public comment period, the 2018-21 MTIP as revised by the proposed amendment will be the final program unless amended, and a final notice will not be published.

#### Added Notes:

Completing a formal MTIP amendment is dictated by the rules established by USDOT for MTIP Amendments and Administrative Modifications. Formal MTIP amendments represent a significant change to a project from the original funding or scope of improvement activities. The various required process steps are intended to demonstrate that as a result of the required changes, no impact upon air conformity, plus fiscal constraint is still maintained, and/or the priorities, policies, and goals established in the approved Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) have not changed.

Formal MTIP amendments normally fall into one or more of the following categories:

- (1) Significantly adds, revises, reduces, or changes the project scope of improvement activities
  - (2) Requires a significant change to the project limits limit (greater than 0.25 miles)
  - (3) Involves a significant cost change (increase or decrease normally 20% or greater)
    - (4) Adds or cancels a project from the MTIP

Based on the 30% design cost estimate for the project, the North Rivergate Blvd overcrossing at the UPRR is fully funded now.

- 7. Other = Additional local funds the lead agency commits to the project above the required match to the federal funds. Referred to as "Overmatch".

#### **Amendment Summary**

This amendment adds the ROW and construction phase funding to the project. By accomplishing this now, the ROW phase can obligate in October 2018 (early FFY 2019) to initiate pre-ROW acquisition activities involving the eventual construction of sound walls as part of the project.
