Metro output

Based on public input, Metro builds possible scenarios for a future garbage and recycling system.

Based on public input, Metro refines a scenario that best represents a shared vision and goals of a future system.

Based on public input, Metro develops draft plan.

Public Input Report summarizing comments on draft plan.

Metro staff presents revised plan to Metro Council for adoption.

Pending Council adoption, implementation of the 2030 Regional Waste Plan begins.
