Metro has indicated the equipment type and the minimum number of units that it believes are necessary and are required to perform the essential duties. Proposal will include these essential number and types of equipment as well as additional equipment and vehicles necessary to fulfill the contract. All tractors, trailers, pickups, and shuttle vehicles must be licensed and DOT road worthy. Proposal will need some equipment that allows for the top loading of material for transport and an appropriate number of containers to collect source-separated depot materials and provide for consolidation and temporary staging of materials.
