1.	n/a	In lieu of emailing large document files, applicants may submit a link to their materials on Dropbox or a similar file-sharing website or FTP site. The link needs to be received by Metro by 4 p.m. on June 21 in order to be eligible. The email should contain the jurisdiction and project name, in addition to the materials or a link to where they may be downloaded.
2.	4,5	Application questions #31 and #48 are duplicates. Please only answer #48.
3.	8	<p>The application signature page has a place for a representative from all impacted railroad companies to sign, indicating they have been notified of the project. A railroad representative signature does not necessarily indicate they are supportive of or will cooperate with development of the project.</p> <p>If you are unable to secure a signature from a railroad company, please include with your application a brief memo detailing your attempts to work with them to secure a signature. ODOT rail should indicate their awareness of the project in all projects that impact the rail system.</p>
