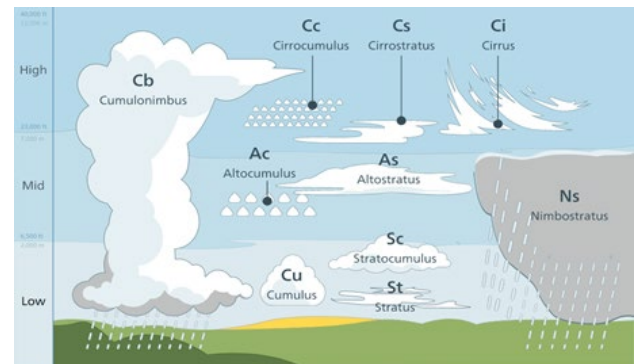

Sky watching.

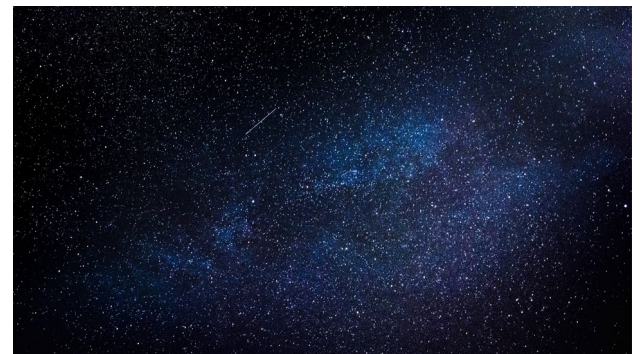
Cloud watching

1. From your porch or looking out your window, look up at the clouds.
2. Notice the different colors, shapes, sizes, and textures.

4. Answer the following questions:
 1. Why do you think some clouds look different or similar to other clouds?
 2. What do the clouds tell you about how the air around you feels?



Stargazing

1. Pick a spot with minimal artificial light and look at the stars when it gets dark and the skies are clear.
2. Using an app, what constellations can you find? Do you see a planet?
