2040 PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT GRANTS PROGRAM AWARDS MADE FOR GRANT CYCLE 7 IN 2019

Metro received 10 grant proposals from 5 local governments and one private entity for the 2019 grant cycle. On July 26, 2019 the Metro Council approved the award of \$2,428,000 of grant funding to support seven projects across the region:
