Tabor 77

Six free-standing small houses around a central common area. These two-story homes combine Northwest Contemporary style with energy-efficient features such as heat pumps and pre-wiring for electric vehicle charging.

Tillamook Row

A zero energy community that includes five buildings — a mix of 5 owner-occupied units and 11 rental units with front porches and balconies oriented around a central courtyard. All five buildings were designed using Passive House standards and produce all their own energy through onsite solar panels.

Detached Backyard ADU

A 420-sq ft 1-Bedroom ADU with a loft built in the backyard of a single-family residential lot. The design maximizes privacy and a sense of ownership for both residences. This design creates a complete home at a below-market rate to help with the housing crisis by being part of the solution - while still being energynet positive and Earth Advantage Certified: Platinum.
