### **Who are sponsorship funds for?**

Organizations and groups led by and for \*\*Black and/or Indigenous people and/or People of Color (BIPOC).

### **What are sponsorship funds for?**

Funds are for activities that build capacity to connect BIPOC communities with nature.

Funds may cover staff time, professional and leadership development, materials and supplies, IT services and hardware, participant stipends, transportation, food and other costs related to connecting BIPOC communities with nature.

### **How much funding is available?**

Individual groups can request up to \$3,500 per request, depending on organizational budget size.
