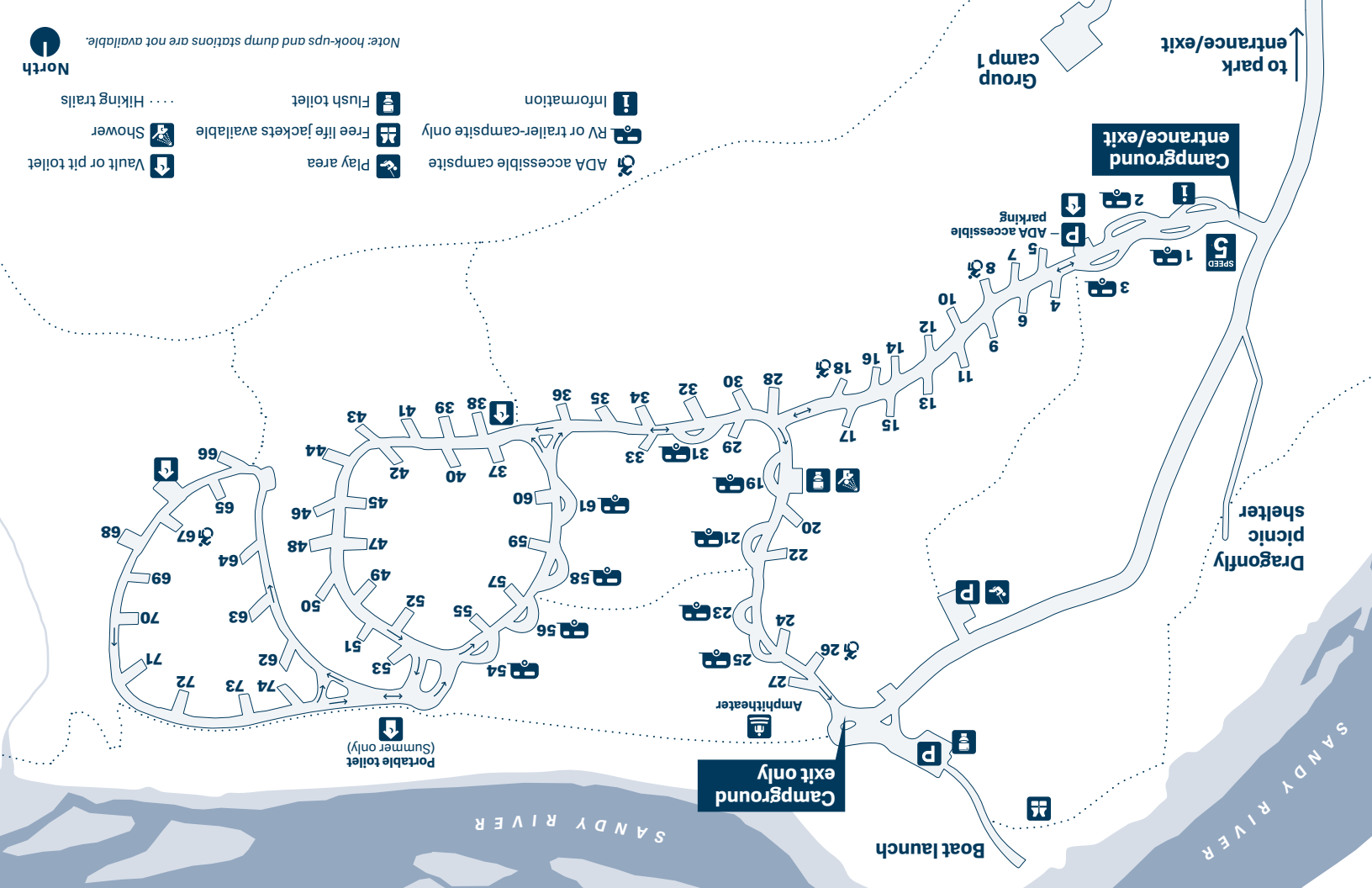




Note: hook-ups and dump stations are not available.

PARKING FEE \$5 per vehicle required first day only.
CHECK-IN 2 p.m. **CHECKOUT** 12 p.m. (noon)
GATES OPEN 6:30 a.m. **GATE CLOSURE** time posted at park entrance.

CAMPGROUND POLICIES

- Camping allowed in designated areas and numbered sites only.
- Reserved sites limited to 14 nights within a 17-night period and a maximum 28 nights in a six-month period.
- Visitors without reservations may camp at unreserved sites one night at a time. If site becomes reserved, visitor must move to another available, unreserved site.
- Maximum of six people and two vehicles per campsite. No accommodations will be made for additional vehicles.
- Pull-through sites are restricted to use by RVs and trailers.
- Do not stick axes, knives, nails or other items into trees or tables.
- Pets are not allowed; they can damage habitat and threaten wildlife.
- Wood fires and charcoal are allowed in designated fire pits and barbecues only and must be attended at all times. Firewood gathering or cutting is prohibited.
- Alcohol, drugs, hunting and fireworks are prohibited.
- Quiet time is 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. No driving or loud noises during this time.

Violators of these or any other park rules are subject to citation and/or eviction. (Metro Code, Title 10)

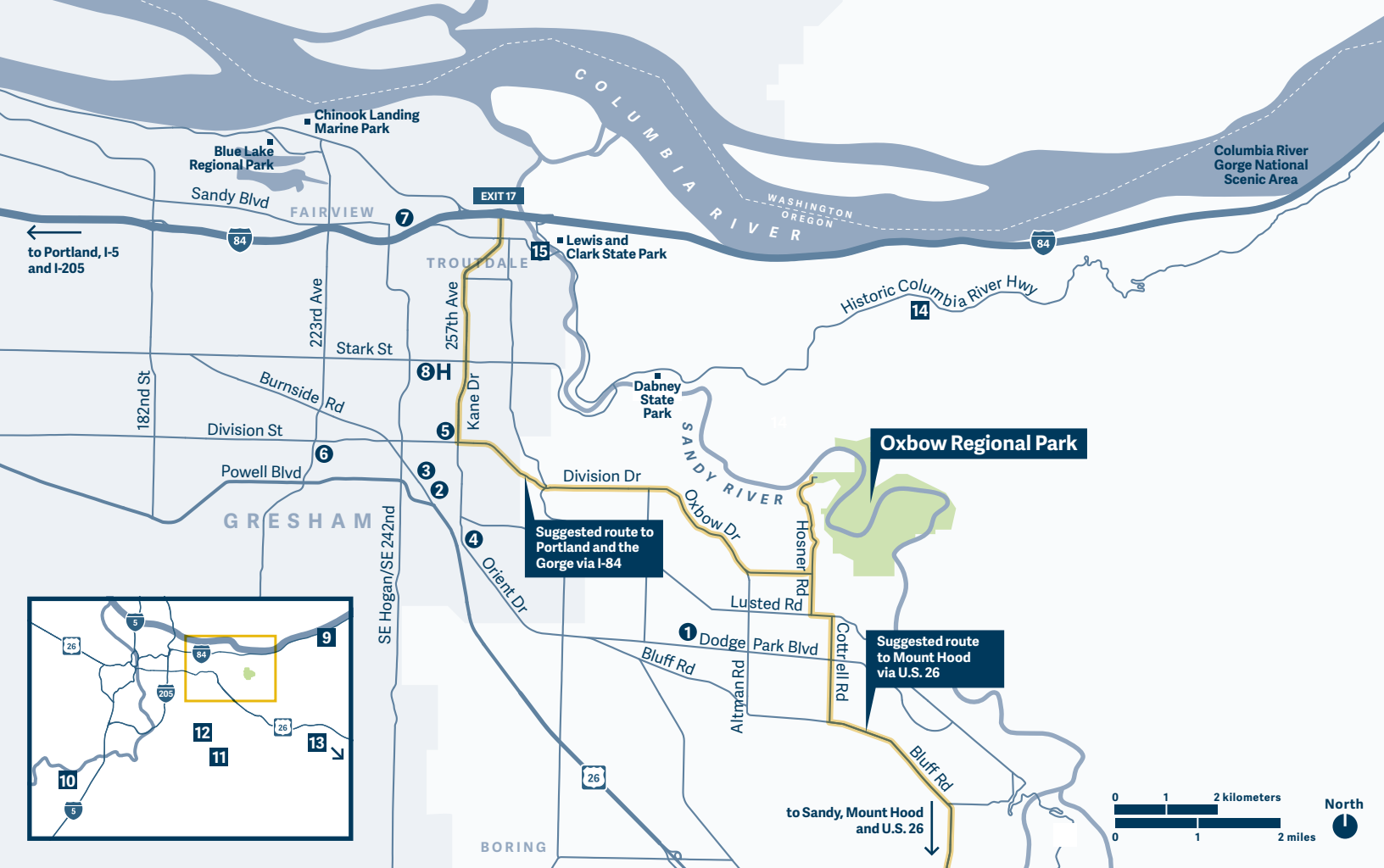
