Worm bin construction

Plastic worm bin

This bin is used mainly for fruit and vegetable trimmings. It is very easy to build and tidy for indoor use. Budget \$6 to \$20 for new materials, or better yet, used salvaged materials.

MATERIALS

Two plastic storage containers with a tight fitting lid. Make sure the containers can be stacked or nested together.

TOOLS

Power drill with ¼" bit.

ASSEMBLY

Drill at least 6 holes per side for ventilation about one half to three quarters of the way up the sides of one of the containers. Drill drainage holes in the bottom of that container as well as the lid. Place the bin with ventilation holes into the second storage container to collect any extra moisture.
