



Bond refinement is the effort to build each of the six programs outlined in the 2019 parks and nature bond measure, which is a promise made by Metro to the voters of the region to build upon its decades of conservation work and continue its mission to protect clean water, restore fish and wildlife habitat, and provide opportunities for people to connect with nature close to home.
