



# Metro Supportive Housing Services Program

## Regional goals and progress markers

### Year 1

- 2,400+ **households** stabilized in permanent housing by June 2022
- 700+ year-round shelter beds created by June 2022 (900+ total from all funding sources including supportive housing funds)
- Expanding infrastructure for culturally specific service providers
- Alignment of data collection and metrics across all three counties

### Overall for 10-year program

- 5,000+ chronically homeless households connected to supportive housing
- 10,000+ households at risk of/experiencing homelessness stabilized in permanent housing

### Regional progress (as of October 2021)

- Shelter
  - Shelter expansion is underway across the region. County partners have already opened new shelter and are hard at work to quickly make hundreds of new beds available by winter
- Permanent housing
  - Dozens of households connected to permanent housing
  - RLRA, a regional long-term rent assistance program, is underway
  - First progress updates due in December
- Services
  - County partners have worked quickly to expand their network of service providers, especially culturally specific organizations. All three counties have released funding notices and have selected many new, emerging and culturally specific service providers. This supports the initial expansion of supportive services and is one way partners work to ensure better access to services for communities of color

### Tax collection

- Tax collection began in April 2021
- As of October 2021, \$2.1 million collected
- The FY 2021-22 forecast is \$180 million in collections
- Most of these collections are expected in April 2022
