As required under Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966, the United States Department of the Interior (DOI), through the National Park Service, has reviewed a draft Section 4(f) evaluation for the transportation project titled "Southwest Corridor Light Rail Project" in Multnomah and Washington Counties, Oregon.

In a report dated September 2021, the Oregon Department of Transportation evaluated Section 4(f) properties affected by the Southwest Corridor Light Rail Project located in Multnomah and Washington Counties.
