The various required process steps are intended to demonstrate that as a result of the required changes, no impact upon air conformity is present, plus fiscal constraint is still maintained, and/or the priorities, policies, and goals established in the approved Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) have not changed. Formal MTIP amendments normally fall into one or more of the following categories: (1) Significantly adds, revises, reduces, or changes the project scope of improvement activities. (2) Requires a significant change to the project limits limit (greater than 0.25 miles). (3) Involves a significant cost change (increase or decrease normally 20% or greater). (4) Adds or cancels a project from the MTIP.
