Introduction: A History of the Habitat Restoration and Educational Grants Program

During the 1970s and early 1980's, there was a well-established concern regarding the management of natural spaces in the Portland-Vancouver area. Citizen groups, commissions, and local government agencies voiced their unease over disappearing natural spaces and debated the best course of action, who should be involved, and who should be in charge. Metro entered this debate by sponsoring several committees and conferences such as The Futures Committee, and conferences like the Columbia-Willamette Futures Citizens Forum Conference, and the Critical Choices Conference. The intent of these committees was to identify areas of critical concern for the future of the Portland metropolitan region. Public comment gathered from the forums consistently reflecting concern over the need for regional planning and cooperation in parks planning.

In 1988, Metro took another step towards a more active role in regional parks planning by conducting a regional parks inventory and study to determine the current state of natural spaces and parks in the Portland region. Metro also created the Greenspaces Program under its Planning Department and assigned Mel Huie as its first employee. Mr. Huie contacted Mike Houck, Urban Naturalist for the Audubon Society of Portland, Barbara Walker with the Forty Mile Loop Land Trust, and other local governments to create the Regional Parks Forum. The Forum met between 1988 and 1992 and brought together federal, state, and local governments, and non-profit conservation organizations to coordinate parks and natural areas studies and inventories. The work and recommendations made by the Regional Parks Forum led to a regional parks study and the development of an implementation plan. The work also yielded a list of parks planning projects that would be developed and executed by Metro in collaboration with regional, state, federal, and the public partners.

At the end of 1988, Metro received recognition for its work in regional parks management through an endorsement received from the Task Force on Metropolitan Regional Government to continue parks planning, coordination, and database management. Metro staff also participated in a Regional Trails and Greenways Working Group with other local governments, state and federal government, and non-profit organizations.

In 1989, several Metro councilors and staff joined a delegation to Washington D.C. to secure congressional funding earmarked for greenspaces planning. During the trip, the delegation approached Senator Mark Hatfield, Chair of the Senate Appropriations Committee, and Oregon Representative Les AuCoin. With their assistance a deal was struck with Illinois Representative Sid Yates to earmark \$1.4 million to fund two years of greenspaces planning. The agreement provided funding for restoration projects in the Portland-Vancouver region and enabled the City of Chicago to fund its Chicago Wilderness Program.

In August 1990, congressional and presidential approval was granted to provide federal funding to both Portland and Chicago to establish urban wetland and wildlife demonstration programs with the intent of developing a model natural resources program that could be used by other cities around the country. Funds were slated to pass through the US Fish and Wildlife Service to Metro to start the Metropolitan Greenspaces Program's restoration grant projects on both sides of the Columbia River. The focus of the grant program was habitat restoration, public outreach, and

regional planning. At the end of 1992, the grant program was extended to include environmental education to expand educational programs to a broader audience in the hope of creating a more comprehensive regional education program.

Funding for the first two years of the grants program was released in March of 1991. Over the next 14 years, Metro and the US Fish and Wildlife Service partnered to oversee the restoration and educational grants program designed to protect greenspaces, water quality, and floodplains; restore wildlife habitat; and expand environmental education. The grants program helped improve the environment, create a sense of community, and inspire other similar projects. For example, in 1991, the City of Lake Oswego and the Lake Oswego Land Trust partnered with the neighborhood near Ball Creek to control erosion, remove non-native vegetation, and plant native vegetation along the creek. This helped to improve the health of the stream and wildlife, control bank erosion, and improved the diversity of the vegetation that provided food and habitat to wildlife. The families in the neighborhood formed connections through their volunteer work and helped develop a management plan for Ball Creek, inspiring other neighborhoods to contact the city about other stream restoration projects. In 1997, Project Discovery worked with 4th and 5th graders to learn about and observe fish and wildlife habitat and understand how humans impact those habitats. In addition to the classroom curriculum, the children were taken out into the field to observe animals and their tracks and remove non-native vegetation from the site. Cascade Geographic Society, one of the organizations involved in Project Discovery, enlisted volunteers to maintain and continue the ongoing enhancement work at the restored site. In 1988, volunteers donated over 1,000 hours of their time.

When the grants program ended in 2005, 331 grants had been awarded with over \$2.6 million in federal funding that was leveraged 4:1 in local contributions. Final reports for several grants were published on the US Fish and Wildlife's website to serve as models to other communities to restore and enhance urban wetlands, streams, riparian corridors, and upland sites. The Habitat Restoration and Educational Grants Program fostered partnerships between local governments, organizations, and the public in support of local conservation of natural areas.

Chronology of the Habitat Restoration and Educational Grants Program

1989 Members of the Metro Council, Mel Huie, Metro Regional Planner, and Mike Houck with the Audubon Society of Portland travel to Washington D.C. to meet with Senator Mark Hatfield, chair of the Senate Appropriations Committee, and Oregon Representative Les AuCoin to seek a congressional earmark for greenspaces planning. They strike a deal with Illinois Representative Sid Yates to fund greenspaces planning for the next two years.

1990 August. Congress and the President earmark federal funds to Portland and Chicago to establish urban wetland and wildlife demonstration programs. The goal was to develop a model natural resources program that could be used by other urban areas around the country.

The funds were designated to pass through the US Fish and Wildlife Service to Metro to start the Metropolitan Greenspaces Program and to fund and complete restoration projects on both sides of the Columbia River. The program was administered by both Metro and the US Fish and Wildlife Service and focused on environmental education, habitat restoration, public outreach, and regional planning throughout the Portland, Oregon/Vancouver, Washington area. Two major deliverables from the program were the *Metropolitan Greenspaces Master Plan* and the Restoration Grants Program.

1991 March 22. \$1 million in federal funding was released to Metro to fund grants for projects involving regional planning to protect greenspaces, habitat, floodplains, and water quality. The funding was allocated over a two-year period.

April 25. The Metro Council adopts Resolution No. 91-1428 to establish guidelines and criteria for the greenspaces demonstration grant program to restore and enhance urban wetlands, streams, and riparian corridors. The \$200,000 designated by the US Fish and Wildlife Services was overseen by the Metro's Greenspaces Program and the Metropolitan Greenspaces Policy Advisory Committee (MGPAC).

May 6. Metro holds pre-application workshops to assist potential grantees with the application process.

July. Metro publishes a report, *Environmental Education in the Metropolitan Area*. This report served as a frame of reference during the creation of the environmental education grant program.

August 8. The Metro Council adopts Resolution No. 91-1490 to award \$143,150 for 12 greenspaces demonstration projects to restore and enhance urban wetlands, streams, and riparian corridors.

1992 March 26. The Metro Council adopts Resolution No. 92-1564 to endorse the US Fish and Wildlife Services' proposed Oregon Ecosystem Program. The program outlined in the US Fish and Wildlife Service's report, *The Oregon Ecosystem Program: A Partnership Approach to Maintaining Biodiversity* proposed coordination between appropriate existing programs and expertise at the private, local, regional, State, and

Federal level to protect natural areas and fish and wildlife habitat. This extended urban natural area planning to other metropolitan areas in the State of Oregon.

May 14. The US Fish and Wildlife Service releases the second year of federal funds for the restoration and enhancement grants under Metro Resolution No. 92-1609.

July 23. The Metro Council approves Resolution No. 92-1637, adopting *The Metropolitan Greenspaces Master Plan*.

September 10. The Metro Council adopts Resolution 92-1669A, approving a public awareness plan for the *Metropolitan Greenspaces Master Plan* and Ballot Measure 26-1. The ballot measure asks the voters of the region if Metro should issue \$200 million of general obligation bonds to buy, develop, maintain, and operate a parks and recreation system consistent with the Greenspaces Master Plan. The public awareness plan includes information on restoration and environmental education grants.

October 8. The Metro Council adopts Resolution No. 92-1674, awarding funds for 10 restoration grants. Note: An additional 8 grants were reworked and resubmitted in November for funding.

November 12. The Metro Council adopts Resolution No. 92-1701, granting funding of the eight reworked grants from October, in addition to one amended project.

A total of \$183,525 were awarded to 12 restoration grants. Note: Six of the original 18 grant projects awarded were withdrawn.

Metro submits a request to the US Fish and Wildlife Service for a third year of funding.

December 22. The Metro Council adopts Resolution No. 92-1720, establishing an environmental education grants program to fund projects via US Fish and Wildlife Services funding. The grant program encourages the use of local natural areas as “living laboratories” to expand community knowledge about urban natural resources. The expectation was that the education programs created would become part of a larger, more comprehensive environmental education program. A Metropolitan Greenspaces Education Grant Committee evaluated the grant applications based on the criteria established in the resolution.

1993 February. Metro awards \$42,790 for 12 environmental education grants. Note: One of the 13 grant projects was withdrawn.

August/September. A committee consisting of Metro councilors and staff, citizen representatives, and staff from the US Fish and Wildlife Service, the Environmental Protection Agency, and the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department perform field visits to the sites and conduct personal interviews with restoration grant applicants. Metro Councilor Richard Devlin serves as the committee chair. In addition to Councilor Devlin, Councilors Susan McLain and Gary Hansen, staff from Metro’s Planning Department, and one member each from the Greenspaces Policy Advisory

Committee (GPAC) and the Greenspaces Technical Advisory Committee (GTAC) served on the committee.¹

November 10. The Metro Council adopts Resolution No. 93-1851, awarding \$100,363 for 14 restoration grant projects. Note: Two of the initial 16 awarded grant projects were withdrawn.

Mel Huie, Metro Regional Planner notifies the Planning Committee that according to Senator Hatfield's office, additional funds may be available for another year. In response, Metro submits a request to the US Fish and Wildlife Service for a fourth year of funding.²

1994 Metro awards \$75,715 for seven restoration grant projects.

March 10. The Metro Council adopts Resolution No. 93-1851, awarding \$59,000 for 16 environmental education grants.

In the Fall, Metro hosts two workshops on grant writing and creating a restoration project. Metro staff provide technical assistance to applicants to develop their grant proposals.

December. A committee of biologists, urban ecologists, planners, and representatives from Oregon State Parks and the Federal Natural Resources Conservation Services, along with two Metro councilors review proposals for the fourth year of the Greenspaces Restoration projects.

1995 January 24. Metro awards \$38,150 for nine environmental education grants.

April 6. The Metro Council adopts Resolution No. 95-2122, awarding \$73,350 for nine restoration grant projects. Note: One the initial ten awarded grant projects was withdrawn.

Metro secures funding for the fifth (FY 95-96) and sixth (FY 96-97) year of the Greenspaces Restoration and Enhancement Grants program.

April 13. The Metro Council adopts Resolution No. 95-2125A extending/amending 19 restoration grants contracts. Grant recipients requested additional time to complete their projects. The additional time resulted in the grants carrying over into the next grant cycle.

July 6. The Metro Council adopts Resolution No. 95-2163A providing eight of the grantees funded from Resolution 94-1908A additional time to complete their projects. Metro also amended the grant project with Washington State University to extend the completion date for the Mill Creek restoration grant project.

November 2. Metro contracts with the Wetlands Conservancy for technical assistance with the restoration grant program. This partnership included working

	with prospective grantees to develop projects; to assist with the review of grant applications; and to provide grantees with technical assistance on the implementation of their projects. The Wetlands Conservancy also assisted with the development of a restoration grant program evaluation tool to document its successes and failures, and to help identify opportunities to improve the program.

Summary Collection Description

The Greenspaces Habitat Restoration and Education Grants Program Collection documents the partnership between Metro's Greenspaces Program and US Fish and Wildlife Services to oversee restoration and educational grants projects in the metropolitan region during the period 1991-2005.

The collection includes a variety of media types such as VHS and audio cassette tapes, photographs, slides, newspaper clippings, oversized maps, and paper reports. The collection also includes sample work from students related to educational grants. Many of the grants include excerpts from publications or in some cases, the full publication of materials referenced in the grants and/or used for educational purposes. It is unclear what permissions for use was given to grantees by the author or authoring agency.

The records were prepared for permanent storage by an intern supervised by Rachel Fox in the Metro's Parks Department. Because the work was done independent of oversight from records management staff, some of the work performed to prepare the records for archiving and permanent storage proved to be problematic. At the end of 2021, Pam Welch, Records and Information Management Analyst, reviewed the contents of the collection and prepared the records for digitization. During the review, the following issues were identified:

- Many of the records had been photocopied onto archival paper using a black and white photocopier. Consequently, color content was lost and images that should have been copied using grayscale lost detail.
- Several fold-out pages were not unfolded before copying.
- It is also unknown if the photocopy work underwent quality assurance to determine if the records were accurately and fully copied.
- Many of the photographs were not properly archived, e.g., left taped and glued to pages. This may have been done out of concern for preserving the context of the objects or concern for the potential of accidentally destroying the photos. Archival steps were taken to properly preserve these records when possible.
- In Box RPG000004, Folders 8 and 17 are missing. It is unknown if the folders were misnumbered or if the records are missing.
- The naming conventions used for the grant titles on the files do not always align with the grant titles captured in the report, *Metropolitan Greenspaces Program Summary of Accomplishments, 1991 to 2005*.
- It is unclear if missing grants are truly missing or if the grantee did not turn in a report.
