Waterleaf

2065 SW River Parkway - Portland - Bridge Housing Corporation

Waterleaf, the second building in a new development by BRIDGE Housing, will provide 176 affordable apartments, in addition to two managers' units. The size of the units will range from studios to three-bedrooms. The site is directly adjacent to the Vera Apartments in the South Waterfront area of downtown Portland. Twenty units will be supported with VASH vouchers. Families and veterans with very low incomes will call this building and this opportunity-rich neighborhood home.

Amenities include laundry, conference room and community classroom, community room with kitchen, outdoor courtyard and playground. Car and bike parking are also included.

A streetcar station and TriMet bus stops are directly adjacent, as are the new Tilikum Crossing, convenient access to OHSU, waterfront trail and Poet's Beach. The development team has maximized allowable parking for retail and office space, focused on native landscaping, and connected with the local neighborhood association.
