2040 PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT GRANTS PROGRAM AWARDS MADE FOR GRANT CYCLE 11 IN 2023

Metro received 17 grant proposals from ten local governments for the 2023 grant cycle. In January 2023 and March 2024, Metro Council approved awards totaling \$4,417,183 in grant funding to support 17 projects across the region.
