1:30 p.m.	Discussion on ODOT Enhance <i>The Oregon Transportation Commission (OTC) approved funds for the Enhance Highway Discretionary Program, to address congestion and freight mobility, also factoring in safety, equity, climate change and multimodal accessibility to pick the best projects. By the end of August, Region 1 will submit ODOT Project Manager proposals and in fall, OTC will decide which to move forward with further scoping. Scoped projects will then be considered in a final decision process before going into ODOT's 2024-2027 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). What are the projects or scope elements that TransPort recommends ODOT pursue for smart, cost-effective investments that yield policy benefits?
