Created in partnership with cities, counties, businesses, community leaders and culturally specific communitybased organizations


Designed to deliver benefits shared by all

14 equity work group meetings 22 community conversations 3,989 survey submissions 3 leadership forums 2,339 online comments 24 technical work group meetings






What's in the plan?



Plan elements

19 goals and more than 100 related actions to help the region achieve its vision by 2030



Advancing equity

40+ actions focus on advancing equity

Identified with green "E" symbol

Outcomes:

- Increase diversity in all garbage and recycling system jobs
- Pay living wages and improve advancement opportunities
- Investments in communities of color
- Access to decision making and leadership opportunities for youth and adults of color
- Inclusive, culturally-relevant education services




Reducing health and environmental impacts

Goals and actions designed to reduce health and environmental impacts across product life cycle

Outcomes:

- Advocate for legislation to get toxics out of products
- Deliver education and implement policies that support better purchasing choices
- Expand opportunities for donation, reuse and repair
- Reduce garbage and recycling operations impacts



Maintaining and improving our garbage and recycling system

Goals and actions designed to create a more equitable and resilient garbage and recycling system

Outcomes:

- Improve collection system, including seven directive actions
- Make our recycling system more adaptable and resilient
- Preparation for debris management and service delivery following a disaster

Three-year work plans to be developed in collaboration with local governments

Measuring progress:

Track using key indicators, goal indicators and annual progress reports

Oversight:

Regional Waste Plan Implementation Committee to oversee progress and report to Metro Council
