"Recycling or Not" activity, Metro west project vision and overview

- **Recycle or Not**: Community advisory group members engaged in an interactive activity where they brought items to the group. Enrique Vargas helped find what local facilities and organizations would be able to recycling or dispose of the item using the Metro "find recyclers" tool online.
- Project vision and overview: Matt Tracy presented the reasons for the transfer station project in the West part of the region now, the history of the project, the purpose of the 2030 Regional Waste Plan, and the property due diligence process. He also discussed the features of state-ofthe-art transfer and recycling centers, including features that mitigate most of the potential impacts.
